


Letting Go!

Mark 11:25 NLT – “But when you are praying, first forgive anyone you are holding a grudge against, so that your Father in heaven will forgive your sins, too.”

HOW to Let Go of Hurt

1. Relinquish _____.

Romans 12:19 TLB – “Dear friends, never avenge yourselves. Leave that to God, for he has said that he will repay those who deserve it. Don't take the law into your own hands.”

Matthew 18:21 NLT – “Then Peter came to him and asked, “Lord, how often should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?” “No, not seven times,” Jesus replied, “but seventy times seven!”

2. Refocus _____.

Philippians 3:13-14 GNT – “The one thing I do is to forget what is behind me and do my best to reach what is ahead. So I run straight toward the goal in order to win the prize, which is God's call through Christ Jesus to the life above.”

Luke 6:27-28 NIV – “Do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.”

Romans 12:14 GNT – “Ask God to bless those who persecute you – yes, ask him to bless, not to curse.”

3. Respond _____.

Romans 12:21 NIV – “Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.”
