5 Great Radical Freedoms through Christ:

1. Gives us A CLEAR CONSCIENCE.

Colossians 1:14 NIRV – "Because of what the Son has done, we have been set free. Because of him, all our sins have been forgiven."

2. Opens up PERSONAL ACCESS TO GOD.

Ephesians 3:12 NV – "In Him and through faith in Him we may approach God with freedom and confidence."

3. Empowers us TO CHOOSE WHAT IS RIGHT.

Romans 6:6-7 NLT – "We know that our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin. For when we died with Christ, we were set free from the power of sin."

Philippians 1:21-24 TLB – "For to me, living means opportunities for Christ, and dying—well, that's better yet! But if living will give me more opportunities to win people to Christ, then I really don't know which is better, to live or die! Sometimes I want to live, and at other times I don't, for I long to go and be with Christ. How much happier for me than being here! But the fact is that I can be of more help to you by staying!"
