It is only by God’s grace that you have been saved!... God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can’t take credit for this; it is a gift from God... For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.”

Galatians 3:3 (GNT) – “How can you be so foolish! You began by God’s Spirit; do you now want to finish by your own power?”
